

OYHA 2009-2010 Hockey Season Fundraising Expectations

Owatonna Youth Hockey Association strives to keep registration costs among the lowest in Southern Minnesota, if not the whole State of Hockey! We fundamentally believe this helps increase participation in a sport that might become very expensive if it weren't for the fundraising we do. Through higher participation, we feel we are able to field more competitive teams and offer a hockey experience that is better than most associations around. If it were not for the successful fundraisers OYHA runs, hockey registration costs would be at least twice what they currently are.

In fact, in the 2008-2009, OYHA generated more revenue from each of charitable gambling, home tournaments and concessions than registration. Obviously, every OYHA member participating in these fundraising activities is key to us keeping hockey affordable and continuously offering more for our players.

For the coming 2009-2010 season, every family will be expected to participate in fundraising in the following ways:

1. Registration (One payment or installment plan)
2. Pancake Breakfast or (50 ticket, 25 ticket or 5 ticket/buy-out)
 - a. Workers for this event are Squirts and Girls 10U plus an adult member of each of their family
3. Pork Commercial Fundraiser (10 ticket minimum or Fundraiser Fee Buy-out Option)
4. Fair Concession
 - a. All teams are required to work this event
5. Parking Lot staffing
 - a. Workers for this event are PeeWees, Girls 12U, Bantams, and Girls 14U plus an adult member of each of their family
6. New this season, we will also be holding a raffle and silent auction in conjunction with the Pork Commercial Dinner. Ticket selling will be completely optional, other than in the concession stand. Donations for raffle and silent auction gratefully accepted!!
7. Tournament Hours participation (Approx. 4 - 7 shifts per player, set-up by team fundraising rep. All parents with the exception of the official team coach(es), maximum 3 coaches per team)
8. Concession hours participation
 - Again this year, 12 hours per player and 5 hours for each additional player
 - 5 hours total for official coaches who are also parents (maximum 3 official coaches per team), to be donated coaching Park and Rec.
 - Board member/parents are expected to contribute a maximum of 5 hours total.
 - Concession stand is open during most multi-game OYHA dates, all high-school and Express games, as well as some dryland events and clean-up in March.

Note: This season, we will be collecting a post-dated check for **\$240 for 1st player and \$100 for each additional** to be held as collateral against concession hours. These checks will not be cashed unless required concession hours/fundraising commitments as indicated above are not worked by March 30, 2010.

OYHA board and members appreciate your help in volunteering, to help keep the cost of hockey affordable for everyone and keep Huskies Hockey successful!
